Diplomirao na Medicinskom fakultetu Univerziteta u Beogradu (1978.). Magistrirao na Medicinskom fakultetu Univerziteta u Tuzli 1983. Doktorirao 1989. na Medicinskom fakultetu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu. Tema: "Korelacijska analiza akcijske, perkusijske i elektromiografske miotonije u miopatija tipa distrofične i kongenitalne miotonije". Zaposlen je u Univerzitetском kliničkom centru Tuzla i Medicinskom fakultetu Univerziteta u Tuzli. Aktualno predstojnik Klinike za neurologiju i Katedre za neurologiju. Prodekan za znanost Medicinskog fakulteta Univerziteta u Tuzli, 1992.-2000.; 2002.-2003. Od 2003. do 2007. godine obnašao dužnost direktora UKC Tuzla za edukaciju i istraživanje. Područje znanstvenog interesa: klinička neuropsihologija, klinička neurofiziologija i neuromuskularne bolesti, demijenizirajuće bolesti. Voditelj više znanstvenih projekata, mentor u 34 magistarska rad i 19 disertacija. Objavio je više od 400 znanstvenih i stručnih radova od čega preko 100 u PubMed indeksaciji, citiran 560 puta. Sudjelovao u pisanju 60 knjiga i udžbenika. At the University of Tuzla he obtained MrSc (1983), and PhD at the University of Zagreb (1989). PhD thesis: The analysis of correlation between action, percussion and electromyographic myotonias in dystrophic and congenital myotonia.

Working at University Clinical centre Tuzla and School of Medicine Univ. of Tuzla. Head of Department and Cathedra of Neurology, University Clinical Center Tuzla. Deputy Director for Science, Research and Education, University Clinical Center Tuzla from 1992.-2000; 2002.-2003. From 2003-2007 director for Education and Research University of Tuzla. Scientific fields of interest: Clinical Neurophysiology, Clinical Neurophysiology and Neuromuscular Disorders, Demyelinated Disorders. Principal of several scientific projects. Mentor of 34 master works and 19 PhD thesis. Published more than 400 professional and scientific papers with more than 100 PubMed indexation, cited more than 560 times.
