



ŽELIMIR JAKŠIĆ, professor emeritus, Medicinski fakultet Sveučilišta u Zagrebu. Specijalist socijalne medicine (higijene i organizacije zdravstvene zaštite).

Rođen 1930. u Zagrebu. Diplomirao na Medicinskom fakultetu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu (1955.), diploma javnog zdravstva ŠNZ „A. Štampar“ 1958., doktorirao s tezom „Ocjena proširenosti šećerne bolesti i njeno otkrivanje“. 1965. Radio u Školi narodnog zdravlja „A. Štampar“ Medicinskog fakulteta u Zagrebu i obavljao dužnost pročelnika Zavoda, predstojnika Katedre, direktora na Fakultetu, prodekana i dekana.

Područje znanstvenog interesa: epidemiologija kroničnih bolesti, primarna zdravstvena zaštita i medicinska edukacija. Voditelj šest velikih međunarodnih projekata, publicirao preko 400 znanstvenih i stručnih radova.

Postignuća: osnivanje katedre opće medicine; osnivanje Zavoda za nastavnu tehnologiju i Edukacijskog multimedijskog centra; interfakultetski studij gerontologije; međunarodni tečajevi s preko 870 sudionika iz 91 zemlje; nastava i udžbenik „Umijeće medicinske nastave“; uspješan projekt primarne zaštite Iran/WHO. Član „ad eundem“ RCGP London, Hipokratova medalja (WONCA-Euro), Redoviti član AMZH od 1972.

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ŽELIMIR JAKŠIĆ, professor emeritus, School of Medicine University of Zagreb, specialist in social medicine (hygiene and organization of health care).

Born 1930 in Zagreb. Graduated at the School of Medicine Zagreb (1955), diploma in Public Health 1958 (School of Public Health A. Štampar). 1965 obtained Ph.D. thesis title “Occurrence of diabetes mellitus and its early detection”.

Worked in the “A. Štampar” SPH, School of Medicine Zagreb, serving as head of department/chair, director, vice-dean and dean in School of Medicine.

Interested in epidemiology of chronic diseases, primary health care and general practice, and medical education.

Leader in 6 major international scientific projects, published over 400 scientific and professional papers.

Achievements: establishment of first chair in general medicine and primary health care, establishment of Department for educational technology and Educational Multimedia Centre, starting university postgraduate training in gerontology, numerous international courses and workshops with more than 850 participants from 91 country, teaching and textbook in Art of medical education, successful primary health care project (Iran/WHO). Member ‘Ad eundem’ RCGP London, Hippocrates medalle (WONCA/Euro).
