Radila je u Klinici za dječje bolesti Zagreb (KDBZ), kao pročelnica Zavoda za laboratorijsku dijagnostiku, voditeljica Referentnog centra za solidne tumore Ministarstva zdravlja RH KDBZ, članica Uprave Klinike, i drugo. Bila je pročelnica Katedre za hematologiju, transfuziologiju, imunologiju i genetiku Zdravstvenog Veleučilišta (ZV-a) i voditeljica Smjera laboratorijske medicine ZV-a u Zagrebu.
