



**MIRO JAKOVLJEVIĆ**, redoviti profesor psihijatrije u trajnom zvanju Medicinskog fakulteta Sveučilišta u Zagrebu, specijalist psihijatar, uža specijalnost biologiska psihijatrija i klinička psihofarmakologija, socijalna psihijatrija. Rođen 1954. u Sarajevu, BiH gdje je diplomirao na Medicinskom fakultetu 1977., magistrirao 1984. i doktorirao 1989. na Sveučilištu u Zagrebu. Radi u KBC Zagreb od 1979., bio je pročelnik Centra za kliničku psihofarmakologiju, pročelnik Zavoda za biologisku psihijatriju i kliničku psihofarmakologiju, Zavoda za shizofreniju Psihijatrijske klinike Rebro. Bio je predstojnik Klinike za psihijatriju u KBC Zagreb (2007.-2015.). Na Medicinskom fakultetu Sveučilišta u Mostaru bio je pročelnik Katedre za psihijatriju (2000.-2013.), prodekan za znanost (2007.-2013.). Područje znanstvenog interesa: klinička psihofarmakologija i kreativna psihofarmakoterapija, biološka psihijatrija i transdisciplinarna integrativna psihijatrija. Voditelj projekata sponzoriranih od Ministarstva znanosti i međunarodnih organizacija. Objavio je 18 knjiga, preko 200 znanstvenih i stručnih radova, a 28 tekstova ima u knjigama drugih autora. Glavni je urednik internacionalnog časopisa *Psychiatria Danubina*. Dobitnik je medalje Svjetske federacije udruženja za biologisku psihijatriju za doprinos radu Predsjedničkog savjeta (2001-2005.) i poticaj razvoju biologiske psihijatrije. Član je Akademije nauka i umjetnosti BiH. Predsjednik je Hrvatskog društva za psihofarmakoterapiju i biologisku psihijatriju HLZ-a i ECNP ambasador za Hrvatsku. Redoviti je član AMZH od 1997.

**MIRO JAKOVLJEVIĆ**, Professor of Psychiatry, University of Zagreb, psychiatrist, subspecialist in biological and social psychiatry and clinical psychopharmacology. Born in 1954 in Sarajevo, B&H, where he graduated from the School of Medicine 1977; master's degree (1984), PhD degree (1989) from the University of Zagreb. Since 1979 he has worked at the University Hospital Centre Zagreb. He was head of the Center for Clinical Psychopharmacology, then Department of Biological Psychiatry and Clinical Psychopharmacology and Department for Schizophrenia. He was Head of the Department of Psychiatry, Faculty of Medicine, University of Zagreb in University Hospital Centre Zagreb (2007-2015), Head of the Department of Psychiatry, School of Medicine, University of Mostar (2000-2013), and the vice-dean for science of the Mostar School of Medicine, B&H (2007-2013). Scientific interest: clinical psychopharmacology and creative psychopharmacotherapy, biological psychiatry and transdisciplinary integrative psychiatry. Main investigator in projects sponsored by the Croatian Ministry of Science and international foundations. He published 18 books and more than 200 scientific and professional papers, 28 chapters in books of other authors. Editor-in-chief of the international journal "Psychiatria Danubina". Awards: medal of the World Federation of Societies for Biological Psychiatry 2005. Member of the Academy of Sciences and Arts of B&H, the president of the Croatian Society for Psychopharmacotherapy and Biological Psychiatry of CMA and ECNP ambasador for Croatia. Full member of CAMS since 1997.
