



VLADIMIR GOLDNER, akademik, redoviti profesor u trajnom zvanju, professor emeritus, Medicinskog fakulteta Sveučilišta u Zagrebu, specijalist internist, kardiolog, umirovljenik.

Rođen 1933. godine u Ogulinu. Diplomirao na Medicinskom fakultetu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu (1959.), doktorirao (1980.) disertacija "Mioglobinemija i mioglobinurija u akutnom infarktu miokarda. Radio u KBC Zagreb od 1970. Obavljao dužnost šefa Koronarne jedinice Zavoda za bolesti srca i krvnih žila Rebro (1973.-1978.). Od 1978. do umirovljenja bio je šef Odjela intenzivne skrbi koronarnih bolesnika, za aritmije i elektrostimulaciju srca u Klinici za bolesti srca i krvnih žila.

Autor je, odnosno koautor 235 stručnih i znanstvenih radova. Kourednik i koautor je jednog kompleta udžbenika iz kardiologije te autor i/ili urednik 28 poglavlja kardiologije. Suvlasnik je 5 patenata. Bio je mentor u 11 disertacija i magistarskih radova, voditelj 10 istraživačkih projekata.

Dobitnik je nagrade grada Zagreba (za 2 pronalaska iz elektrokardiologije), Zlatne medalje Udruženja kardiologa Jugoslavije, Strossmayerove nagrade za najbolje znanstveno djelo ("Klinička kardiologija"), Državne nagrade za životno djelo.

Redoviti je član AMZH od 1988. godine.

VLADIMIR GOLDNER, Academician, University Professor, Professor Emeritus, Faculty of Medicine University of Zagreb, specialist in internal medicine, cardiologist, retired.

Born 1933 in Ogulin. Graduated from the Faculty of Medicine, University of Zagreb (1959), Ph.D. (1980) thesis title "Myoglobinaemia and myoglobinuria in acute myocardial infarction". Worked in KBC Zagreb from 1970, as head of Coronary Unit of the Institute for Heart & Vessel Diseases (1973-1978). From 1978 until his retirement he was head of the Department of Intensive Care of Coronary Patients, for arrhythmias and pacing in the Clinic for Heart & Vessel Diseases.

He is author or co-author of 235 professional and scientific papers. Co-editor and co-author of one set of textbooks in cardiology and the author and/or editor of 28 chapters of cardiology. Co-owner of 5 patents. He was mentor to 11 dissertations and master's thesis, head of 10 research projects. Awards: Award of the City of Zagreb (2 inventions in electrocardiology), Gold Medal of the Association of Cardiologists of Yugoslavia, Strossmayer prize for the best scientific work ("Clinical Cardiology"), National Award for Lifetime Achievements.
