



Izv.prof.dr.sc. **Tatjana Vilibić-Čavlek**, prim.dr.med., spec. mikrobiologije, zaposlena je u Hrvatskom zavodu za javno zdravstvo (HZJZ) i Medicinskom fakultetu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu. Voditeljica je Odjela za virološku serologiju, Referentnog centra Ministarstva zdravstva za dijagnostiku i praćenje virusnih zoonoza, Nacionalnog referentnog laboratorijskog arboviruse te Laboratorijske dijagnostike HIV-a i virusa hepatitisa u okviru Centra za dobrovoljno HIV savjetovanje i testiranje pri HZJZ. Sudjelovala je kao voditelj i suradnik na više stručnih i znanstvenih projekata Svjetske zdravstvene organizacije (WHO) i Ministarstva znanosti, obrazovanja i mladih. Bila je voditeljica projekta Hrvatske zaklade za znanost (HRZZ; 2017-2021. godine): Prevalencija i molekularna epidemiologija emergentnih i re-emergentnih neuroinvazivnih arbovirusnih infekcija na području Hrvatske; CRONEUROARBO. Sudjelovala je u organizaciji i bila voditeljica brojnih znanstvenih i stručnih skupova održanih uz potporu WHO i HRZZ. Zamjenica je glavnog urednika časopisa Veterinaria Italiana (Italija) te je član uredničkih odbora u časopisima *Frontiers in Microbiology - Virology Section* (Švicarska), *Arhiv veterinarske medicine* (Srbija) i *Infektološki glasnik* te je gost urednik tematskih brojeva "Emerging and Neglected Viruses and Zoonoses" i "Emerging and Neglected Pathogens in the Balkans" u časopisu *Pathogens* te "Ecology, Evolution and Epidemiology of Zoonotic and Vector-Borne Infectious Diseases" u časopisu *Microorganisms*. Objavila je više od 300 znanstvenih i stručnih radova, poglavljia u knjigama te sažetaka prikazanih na međunarodnim i domaćim skupovima.

Assoc. Prof. **Tatjana Vilibić-Čavlek**, MD, PhD, Medical Microbiology Specialist, works at the Croatian Institute of Public Health (CIPH) and the School of Medicine University of Zagreb. She is the Head of the Reference Center for Diagnosis and Surveillance of Viral Zoonoses of the Croatian Ministry of Health, the National Reference Laboratory for Arboviruses, and the Laboratory for HIV and Viral Hepatitis Diagnostics at CIPH. She has participated as a project leader or collaborator on several scientific projects supported by the World Health Organization (WHO) and the Ministry of Science and Education. She was a principal investigator on a project funded by the Croatian Science Foundation (2017-2021): "Prevalence and molecular epidemiology of emerging and re-emerging neuroinvasive arboviral infections in Croatia"; CRONEUROARBO. She has participated in the organization of several scientific conferences supported by the WHO and the Croatian Science Foundation. She is Deputy Editor-in-Chief of the Veterinaria Italiana journal (Italy) and Editorial Board member in the journals: *Frontiers in Microbiology - Virology Section* (Switzerland), *Archives of Veterinary Medicine* (Serbia), and *Croatian Journal of Infection*. She was a Guest Editor of the Special Issues "Emerging and Neglected Viruses and Zoonoses" and "Emerging and Neglected Pathogens in the Balkans" (*Pathogens* journal) and "Ecology, Evolution, and Epidemiology of Zoonotic and Vector-Borne Infectious Diseases" (*Microorganisms* journal). She has published more than 300 scientific and professional papers, book chapters, and abstracts presented at international and domestic conferences.
