



Prof dr **Josip Paladino**, rođen u Splitu 15.9.1950. Diplomirao na Medicinskom fakultetu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu 1974. 1975 asistent u Zavodu za anatomiju "Drago Perović" Medicinskog fakulteta Sveučilišta u Zagrebu. 1978. započinje specijalizaciju iz neurokirurgije u Klinici za neurokirurgiju Kliničkog bolničkog centra Zagreb. 1981. godine završava poslijediplomski studij na prirodoslovno-matematičkom fakultetu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu i brani magistarski rad. 1984. godine položio specijalistički ispit iz neurokirurgije. 1985. godine postaje znanstveni asistent Medicinskog fakulteta Sveučilišta u Zagrebu. 1988. obranio doktorsku disertaciju i postaje doktor medicinskih znanosti. 1988. izabran za docenta za predmet neurokirurgija Medicinskog fakulteta Sveučilišta u Zagrebu. 1988. izabran za voditelja odjela za neurovaskularnu kirurgiju Klinike za neurokirurgiju Kliničkog bolničkog centra Zagreb. 1995. izabran za predstojnika Klinike za neurokirurgiju Kliničkog bolničkog centra Zagreb. 1998. izabran za izvanrednog profesora za predmet neurokirurgija Medicinskog fakulteta Sveučilišta u Zagrebu. 1999. dobio naslov Primarius. 2002 ravnatelj Kliničkog bolničkog centra Zagreb. 2005. postaje Znanstveni savjetnik. 2007. izabran za redovitog profesora za predmet neurokirurgija Medicinskog fakulteta Sveučilišta u Zagrebu. 2012. izabran za redovitog profesora u trajnom zvanju za predmet neurokirurgija Medicinskog fakulteta Sveučilišta u Zagrebu. Od 2018 radi u Specijalnoj bolnici Radiochirurgija. Od 2018. predstojnik Klinike za neurokirurgiju u Sveučilišnoj kliničkoj bolnici Mostar (BiH). Prof. Paladino objavio je 247 znanstvenih i stručnih radova, sudjelovao u radu 11 stručnih društava i bio voditelj tri znanstvena projekta. Bio je poredsjednik Hrvatskog neurokirurškog društva 1998-2008 godine, a 2013-2018 predsjednik Hrvatskog društva za lubansjku osnovicu. Aktualno se u SB Radiochirurgia posvetio radiokirurškom liječenju tumora središnjeg živčanog sustava, tretmanu aretriovenskih malformacija i funkcijskih zahvatima primjenom radiokirurške tehnike. U Klinici za neurokirurgiju Sveučilišne kliničke bolnice Mostar bavi se neurokirurškim operacijama tumora središnjeg živčanog sustava, tumorima lubanjske baze i posebice vaskularnim neurokirurškim zahvatima.

## Prof. Dr. **Josip Paladino**

Born in Split on September 15, 1950

Graduated from the School of Medicine at the University of Zagreb in 1974.

In 1975, he became an assistant at the “Drago Perović” Department of Anatomy, School of Medicine, University of Zagreb.

In 1978, he began his specialization in neurosurgery at the Neurosurgery Clinic of the Clinical Hospital Center Zagreb.

In 1981, he completed postgraduate studies at the Faculty of Science, University of Zagreb, and defended his Master's thesis.

In 1984, he passed the specialist exam in neurosurgery.

In 1985, he became a scientific assistant at the School of Medicine, University of Zagreb.

In 1988, he defended his doctoral dissertation and became a Doctor of Medical Sciences.

In 1988, he was appointed Assistant Professor in the field of neurosurgery at the School of Medicine, University of Zagreb.

In 1988, he was appointed head of the Department of Neurovascular Surgery at the Neurosurgery Clinic, Clinical Hospital Center Zagreb.

In 1995, he was appointed head of the Neurosurgery Clinic at the Clinical Hospital Center Zagreb.

In 1998, he was appointed Associate Professor in the field of neurosurgery at the School of Medicine, University of Zagreb.

In 1999, he was awarded the title of Primarius.

In 2002, he became the Director of the Clinical Hospital Center Zagreb.

In 2005, he became a Scientific Advisor.

In 2007, he was appointed Full Professor in the field of neurosurgery at the School of Medicine, University of Zagreb.

In 2012, he was appointed Full Professor with permanent tenure in the field of neurosurgery at the School of Medicine, University of Zagreb.

Since 2018, he has worked at the Radiochirurgia Special Hospital.

Since 2018, he has been the head of the Neurosurgery Clinic at the University Clinical Hospital Mostar (Bosnia and Herzegovina).

Prof. Paladino has published 247 scientific and professional papers, participated in the work of 11 professional societies, and was the leader of three scientific projects. He served as Vice President of the Croatian Neurosurgical Society from 1998 to 2008 and as President of the Croatian Society for Skull Base Surgery from 2013 to 2018.

Currently, at the Radiochirurgia Special Hospital, he focuses on radiosurgical treatment of central nervous system tumors, the treatment of arteriovenous malformations, and functional procedures using radiosurgical techniques.

At the Neurosurgery Clinic of the University Clinical Hospital Mostar, he is involved in neurosurgical operations on central nervous system tumors, skull base tumors, and particularly vascular neurosurgical procedures.
