



VALERIJA BRALIĆ LANG, naslovna docentica i viša znanstvena suradnica na Katedri za obiteljsku medicinu Medicinskog fakulteta Sveučilišta u Zagrebu, primarijus, zaposlena u Specijalističkoj ordinaciji obiteljske medicine, na području Doma zdravlja Zagreb-Zapad od 1999. godine. Znanstveni i stručni rad obilježava kontinuirana aktivnost na polju istraživanja sveobuhvatne i kontinuirane zdravstvene zaštite pojedinaca s multimorbiditetom i komorbiditetom u primarnoj zdravstvenoj zaštiti. Osobit značaj pridaje preventivnim kao i inovativnim dijagnostičkim aktivnostima kod kroničnih nezaraznih bolesti. Aktivni je istraživač u nekoliko projekata i kliničkih istraživanja, a područja znanstvenog djelovanja su razvoj znanstveno istraživačkog rada u obiteljskoj medicini, primarna i sekundarna prevencija kroničnih nezaraznih bolesti, adherencija, klinička inercija, primjena novih tehnologija u svakodnevnom radu i mogućnosti utjecaja na promjene nezdravih oblika ponašanja. Glavni je mentor za specijalizaciju iz obiteljske medicine od 2017. godine, te mentor brojnim doktorantima i studentima. Aktivno sudjeluje na domaćim i međunarodnim kongresima. Do sada je publicirala 90 stručnih ili znanstvenih radova, od čega 16 radova u časopisima indeksiranim u Current Contents-u, autorica je 12 poglavlja u osam knjiga od čega je jedna na engleskom jeziku. Recenzent je u 18 međunarodnih znanstvenih časopisa, kongresa World Organization of Family Doctors Europe. Redovita je članica AMZH od 2025. godine.

Associate Professor and Senior Research Associate at the Department of Family Medicine, Faculty of Medicine, University of Zagreb, primarius, employed in the Specialist Family Medicine Practice in the Zagreb-West Health Center area since 1999. Her scientific and professional work is marked by continuous activity in the field of research into comprehensive and continuous health care for individuals with multimorbidity and comorbidity in primary health care. She attaches particular importance to preventive as well as innovative diagnostic activities in chronic non-communicable diseases. She is an active researcher in several projects and clinical research, and her areas of scientific activity are the development of scientific research work in family medicine, primary and secondary prevention of chronic non-communicable diseases, adherence, clinical inertia, the application of new technologies in everyday work and the possibility of influencing changes in unhealthy behaviors. She has been the main mentor for specialization in family medicine since 2017, and a mentor to numerous doctoral candidates and students. She actively participates in domestic and international congresses. So far, she has published 90 professional or scientific papers, of which 16 papers in journals indexed in Current Contents, and is the author of 12 chapters in eight books, one of which is in English. She is a reviewer in 18 international scientific journals, as well as the World Organization of Family Doctors Europe congress. A full member of the Croatian Academy of Medical Sciences since 2025.
